

How to shoot fireworks safely

1. Age at least 18 years.



2. Only shoot fireworks between 6 pm and 2 am.



3. Find an open space and make sure the fireworks will fly away from people and buildings.



4. Use a fireworks launcher and suitable supports.



5. Have safety goggles for everyone and hearing protectors for children.



6. Light the fuse with your arm straight, bending down a bit.

Use a lighting stick to make lighting easier. Stand back from the product to a safe distance.



7. Get a dud? Do not try to light it again!

Wait for at least 10 minutes until you go back to a dud. To prevent a dud from ever going off, keep it in a bucket of water long enough to soak it thoroughly.



8. Collect the rockets, sticks and rubbish on the next day at the latest.
