Purpose of the processing of personal data

Name: identification of the person, notifications, communication; Address: notifications, communication; Telephone number: communication, acquisition of more information; E-mail address: notifications, communication; Employer: targeting of events; Company: targeting of events

Personal data retention period

Personal data is retained for at most two years after giving feedback or a response.

Right of access

A data subject may ask Tukes whether their personal data has been entered in a Tukes register, and if such data exists, what kind of information has been registered (data subject's right to obtain access to data). The data subject may ask for any inaccurate or erroneous data to be rectified.

Right to request erasure of data

The data subject has the right to demand that the controller erase any personal data concerning them. The data subject has the right to withdraw their consent at any time.

Right to restrict processing

If the data subject contests the accuracy of their personal data, they may request that the processing of their personal data be restricted until Tukes has verified the accuracy of the data.

Right to data portability

Persons entered in Tukes' registers do not have the right to request data to be transferred from one system to another.

Right to object

The data subject does not have the right to object to the processing of their data.

Automated individual decision making, including profiling

Automated individual decision making and profiling are not the only methods used by Tukes in its registers.

Notification of a personal data breach to the data subject

If the personal data breach is likely to constitute a high risk to the data subject's rights and freedoms, Tukes shall inform the data subject about the personal data breach without undue delay.

Consequences of failure to provide data

Tukes cannot contact any persons who give feedback.

Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority

The data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Ombudsman if they are of the opinion that the General Data Protection Regulation has been violated during the processing of their personal data.
